

**INFORMATION TO CANDIDATES FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION
FOR ADMISSION TO VETERINARY FIELD ASSISTANT TRAINING
COURSE FOR THE YEAR, 2022-23**

1. Selection of candidate:

The Selection Board shall hold and conduct a written Entrance Examination on such date, place and time as specified in the notification by the Government in this behalf.

2. Syllabus, standard and duration for the entrance examination :

- i) The syllabi and standard for the entrance examination will be the same as in the case of Class-X standard prescribed by the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur.
- ii) The duration of the examination is 90 minutes in the following subjects with the total marks allotted against each subject as below :

Physics	-	30
Chemistry	-	30
Biology	-	40
		100 marks

The duration of the examination and the maximum marks could be increased or decreased at the discretion of the Selection Board.

3. Eligibility and Qualification for appearing the Entrance Examination :

In order to make eligible for appearing at the Entrance Examination, a candidate must have

- i) been a domicile of Manipur
- ii) attained the age of 17 years and shall not exceed 25 years of age as on 1st July, 2022. However, the upper age limit is relaxable for 3(three) years in respect of ST/SC and OBC candidates.
- iii) Passed Class-X Standard / Equivalent Examination from a recognized Board/Council.



4. Application form from the candidates should reach to the Office of the Director, Veterinary & A.H. Services, Manipur by such date and time as the Government may from time to time, specify.
5. The following documents shall be enclosed along with the Application form :
- (i) Photostat copies of Mark Sheet, Provisional Certificate of HSLC/Equivalent (Class-X) examination and Admit card for age proof duly attested by a Gazetted Officer shall be enclosed.
 - (ii) Certificate of character from the Principal of the School last attended duly attested by a Gazetted Officer shall be enclosed.
 - (iii) Three recent passport size photographs of candidate attested by a Gazetted Officer to be affixed, one in the application form and two in the admit card in the space provided.
 - (iv) Domicile/Residential Certificate from the Deputy Commissioner or an Officer authorized by D.C. of the District to which the candidate belongs shall be enclosed.
 - (v) In case of Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribes or OBC candidates, a certificate on that behalf from the District Magistrate or an Officer authorized by D.C. of the District to which the candidate belongs shall be enclosed.
 - (vi) Health/Medical Fitness Certificate issued by a Medical Officer of the State/Central Government shall be enclosed.
 - (vii) A Demand Draft of Rs 800/- (Rupees eight hundred) only for General/OBC candidates and Rs 500/- (Rupees five hundred) only for ST/SC candidates from any Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of the Director, Vety. & A.H. Services, Manipur being the charge of Examination Fee shall be enclosed.



INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES

- i) The competitive Test shall be in English Medium only.
- ii) Four probable answers have been given against each question. Only one of them is the correct answer. The correct answer must be written in the space provided.
- iii) Use ball pen or ink. Candidates should bring their own pens. Only blue/black ink should be used.
- iv) Candidates should verify the correct number of leafs and legibility of test booklet before they start answering the question. Any discrepancy should be brought to the notice of the invigilator immediately. Any complain in such matter will not be entertained after the candidates have started writing the answer sheet.
- v) Normally, no candidates shall be allowed or admitted to the Examination Hall 15 minutes after the commencement of the examination.
- vi) Candidates shall not be allowed any textual material, bits of paper or any other material printed or written except the Admit Card inside the examination hall.
- vii) Hand bags, calculators & cellular phones are not allowed inside the examination hall.
- viii) Candidates should not write their names and roll nos. in any part of the answer sheet except in the column provided for the purpose.
- ix) Use of any unfair means by a candidate may lead to immediate expulsion from the examination hall.
- x) In case of necessity, any further instruction (s) to candidates may be issued by authority before the Entrance Examination.
